

TGEU Submission to UK Government Consultation 'Gender Recognition Act (2004)'

TGEU made a submission to the <u>public consultation</u> on the reform of the UK Gender Recognition Act 2004, adding our voice to the many asking for an overhaul of the gender recognition law.

Our main asks are:

- demedicalisation of gender recognition procedures, including removal of proof of a mental health diagnosis
- removal of any abusive requirements, such as 'real-life-experience', spousal veto, age barriers, or identity within the gender binary (male/ female)
- introduction of a quick, transparent, accessible procedure based on self-determination
